How are Entries Judged?



Blind Adjudications

- Jurors are blocked from viewing information about the students entering the work. Entries are judged on their merit, and only their merit.
- **Our Three Criteria**
- Originality
- Technical skill
- Emergence of a Personal Voice or Vision
